Ioan Mircea Paşcu MEP is Vice President of the European Parliament, Vice Chair of the Committee on Foreign Affairs (AFET) and S&D Coordinator for Security and Defence. Before 2007 he was Observer in the European Parliament. Since 2007, Ioan Mircea Paşcu is Vice Chair AFET, working on CFSP / CSDP matters, including as Rapporteur for the EU's CSDP, mutual defence and security clauses and the strategic situation in the Black Sea. Since 1990, he has held high political and public office positions, including as Minister of Defence of Romania (2000-2004), contributing substantially to the admission of Romania into NATO. Since 1990, Ioan Mircea Paşcu is professor of International Relations at the National University of Political and Administrative Studies.
